
[i] Mass Dharna at the call of UFBU

Full Text of Circular No.31/2022 of BEFI dt. 12.07.2022

Quote UFBU have announced several programme against move for bank privatisation starting with Twitter campaign on 17th July 2022, details of which will be informed in due course.

It has been decided that a Mass Dharna will be held in front of Parliament on 21st July 2022, during the monsoon session starting on 18th next. The Dharna will be joined by the leaders and activists of the constituents of UFBU.

We have decided that the Mass Dharna will be participated by representatives from our state Federations and bank level all India Federations/Unions with larger participation from Delhi and adjoining states viz. Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh.

We advise our state Federations and all India Federations/Unions to nominate two comrades each for participating in the Dharna. Arrangements for Journey and Accommodation are to be made by the respective Committees.

Recently, we are coming across media coverage on bank privatization stating that necessary amendments of the existing Laws may be taken up in the ensuing monsoon session of Parliament. UFBU has announced to observe countrywide bank strike on short notice looking to the developments in the Parliament for which we must remain prepared to plunge into strike action. **Unquote**
