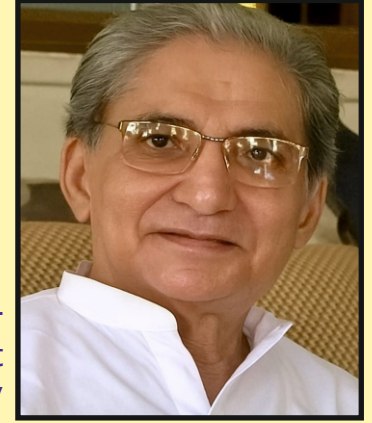

## OBITUARY

### **\*\* Red Salute to Com. Ashoke Kumar Ghosh\*\***

A timeless advocate for Bank Workers, Com. Ashoke Kumar Ghosh, breathes his last on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2025 at 1-00 A.M., leaving lasting legacy of commitment and acumen in trade union movement.



With profound sadness, we announce the passing of Com. Ashoke Kumar Ghosh, a stalwart trade union leader and champion of trade union rights at UCO Bank, in particular and Bank employees in general. He was ninety years old and he left behind his brother, daughter, son-in-law, grand-daughters and uncountable number of comrades in arm.

He was a commerce graduate and completed his LLB degree. Then he joined the Bank in the year 1963 in clerical cadre. From the very beginning he was associated with trade union movement.

His tireless efforts and unwavering dedication to the welfare of bank employees earned him immense respect and admiration from colleagues, union members and the banking community at large.

He was Vice President of All India Federation of UCO Bank Employees and was very popular in Head Office and became Secretary of Calcutta State Committee of UCBEA in undivided union and continued in the same position upto 1984 and after a brief pause he was again elected as Secretary in 1988. In the year 1989 he was elected as General Secretary of All India Body of UCBEA. From the foundation of BEF-West Bengal and BEFI he was Joint Secretary and Vice President respectively over there. Till his death he was attached with UCO Bank Employees' Association as Adviser.

He was also a sports lover and Member of Mohun Bagan Athletic Club, Cricket Association of Bengal and also associated with cultural activities. He was attached to UCO Bank Staff Club and also actively associated with Co-operative movement.

During his illustrious career, Com. Ghosh played a pivotal role in shaping the trade union movement in UCO Bank, negotiating for better working conditions, salaries and benefits for employees and ex-employees. His leadership and vision inspired countless individuals and his legacy will continue to influence the banking industry for years to come.

While alive he donated his body for scientific research and welfare. Accordingly his body was handed over to Anatomy Dept. of National Medical College, Kolkata in presence of his family members and followers.

We remember Com. Ashoke-da for his unrelenting passion, his ability to bring people together and his unwavering dedication to the cause of labour rights and leftist politics. Throughout his life he was associated with left and democratic movement. He was a strong believer of Marxist Ideology. His contributions to trade union movement will always be cherished and his memory will be honoured by all who knew him.

We trust his legacy will continue to inspire future generations of trade union leaders.

We are confident he will be remembered for his selfless service and commitment to banking community.
