
BEFI must be invited in the discussion on Medical Insurance Scheme

Sir,

Discussion on Medical Insurance Scheme

We came across a communication issued by Shri Brajeshwar Sharma, Senior Advisor (HR&IR), Indian Banks' Association (IBA) to the Convener, United Forum of Bank Unions (UFBU) with No. HR&IR/OTH/XIBPS/11267 dated 02.06.2022.

In the said communication, it has been mentioned that a meeting will be held regarding Medical Insurance Scheme on 08.06.2022 at 3 PM at IBA Committee Room, WTC, Cuffe Parade, Mumbai.

As per the said communication, representatives from all constituents of UFBU except BEFI are to attend the meeting. We express our strong reservation to such whimsical approach of IBA for keeping BEFI out of the discussion.

It may please be noted that, representative of BEFI attended the meeting regarding Medical Insurance Scheme between IBA and UFBU held on 08.07.2021 as per IBA communication dated 07.07.2021. We strongly demand that BEFI must be invited in the meeting slated on 08.06.2022 for discussion on Medical Insurance Scheme.

Moreover, Bank Employees Federation of India is an integral part of United Forum of Bank Unions since its formation 25 years ago. We feel that inviting UFBU for a discussion without BEFI tantamount to unwarranted effort of isolating BEFI from UFBU. We strongly suggest for taking necessary initiatives to ensure that IBA refrain from any such activity in the future.
