This time we are witnessing something that did not happen even in the horrible situation of the past. This the first time bank employees were also attacked by extremists.



### **Selective killings in Kashmir Valley**

As you are well aware that the selective killings are going on in Kashmir Valley and one among those was a EDB Bank employee also. This has create fear among also and Kashmir police also directed us to be away from branches for some period and after intimating you, our employees has left Kashmir valley and shifted to Jammu. Most of the non local employees of various organisations including Teachers, State Govt. employees, EDB bank employees, PNB, SBI, J&K Grameen Bank employees and others have also shifted from Kashmir to Jammu. After consulting the other effected employees, a common platform has decided as under:-

**[P.T.O.]**

1. That, since it will be very difficult and risky to stay in Kashmir Valley till normalcy is restored, employees should be adjusted in Jammu province branches.
2. Employees should not be forced to move to Kashmir.
3. Till such decision is taken by administrative office, employees should be treated on special leave.

We, the following constituents from officers fraternity and award staff request as under:-

1. That, employees posted in Kashmir Valley branches should be posted in Jammu area branches till normalcy is restored in Kashmir.
2. Kashmir based employees who are now staying at Jammu after having security threats, should be treated on special leave from date of migration till date of adjustment in Jammu branches.
3. In no case the Kashmir based employees should be forced to move back as if GOD forbid if any unwanted thing happens, who will be held responsible.

We request you to kindly consider our request on humanitarian basis and allow the valley based employees to work from Jammu area branches, till normalcy is restored there.
