Red Salute to Com. Pran Nath Mishra (popularly known as P N Mishra). A timeless fighter for the causes of Bank Workers, Com. P N Mishra, breathes his last on 3rd September 2025 at 4-00 A.M. leaving lasting legacy of commitment and acumen in trade union movement

With heavy heart, we announce the passing of Com. P N Mishra, a stalwart trade union leader and champion of trade union rights in UCO Bank, in particular and Bank employees in general. He was 75 years old and left behind his son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, grand-daughters and grand-sons and uncountable numbers of comrades and followers.

Born on 05/08/1951, he became a master of commerce and completed his LLB degree. Then he joined the Bank in 1973 in clerical cadre and retired from Bank's service on 31.08.2011. From the very beginning he was associated with trade union movement and joined the path of struggle enriched by philosophy of struggle popularized by the then iconic leaders of UCBEA.

His determined hard work and untiring dedication to the welfare of bank employees earned his immense respect and appreciation from colleagues, union members and the banking community at large.

In course of journey he was Joint secretary, Vice President and Senior Vice President of our All India Body and leader of BEF-Delhi as well as BEF- U.P. and founder leader and Secretary of Delhi State Committee of UCBEA. Till his death he was attached with UCO Bank Employees' Association as Advisor of UP State body and as a member of CEC. For his immense effort, courage and conviction he converted UP into a strong base of UCBEA. Besides he contributed building organization in HP, MP, J&K, Haryana and Rajasthan in early days of formation of state body. He was a leader of BEFI also.

During his illustrious career, Com. Mishra played a pivotal role in shaping the trade union movement in UCO Bank. His leadership and vision inspired countless individuals and his legacy will continue to influence the banking industry for years to come.

We remember Com. Mishraji for his consistent passion, his ability to bring people together and his unwavering dedication to the cause of his trust. He was a strong believer of working class struggle. He will always be cherished and his memory will be honoured by all who knew him.

We trust his legacy inspire future generations of trade union leaders.
