## **Full Text of Circular No.20/2023 of BEFI dt. 27.03.2023**

### **Quote**

We have come across an Order issued by Ministry of Communications, Department of Posts, Government of India dated 26 Apr 2023 through which the recognition to the All India Postal Employees Union (AIPEU– Group C) as well as National Federation of Postal Employees (NFPE) are withdrawn.

The recognition of NFPE and AIPEU – Group C has been withdrawn on the basis of false, fake, fabricated and concocted complaint of an unrecognized organization of the postal employees having ideological commitments similar to the ruling political party at the centre.

The NFPE and AIPEU – Group C, as a part and parcel of Confederation of Central Government Employees and Workers – our fraternal Organisation, has been consistently opposing the destructive policies of the Government of India along with the working class and peasantry of the country. The decision of withdrawal of recognition should not be considered in isolation. This is nothing but another glaring example of the central government's ulterior motive of suppressing voices of dissent, in this case target is trade union organisations.

Bank Employees Federation of India condemns such heinous action of the Govt and unequivocally demands for restoration of the recognition of AIPEU and NFPE immediately. The NFPE has decided and announced for sustained agitational programme against such authoritarian approach. While expressing our solidarity to NFPE, we call upon our Units and Affiliates to extend all cooperation and support to the struggle.
