
### **Agitation Programme**

### **Full Text of Circular No.11/2022 of BEFI dt. 26.02.2022**

#### **Quote**

The MoU for 11<sup>th</sup> Bipartite Settlement was signed hurriedly during the first wave of pandemic without finalisation of several sensitive issues like 5-day week, enhancement of family pension, updation of pension etc. Subsequently, enhancement of family pension found place in the final settlement which was approved by the Govt for implementation with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021.

A 'Supplementary minutes of Discussions on certain issues' was signed on 10<sup>th</sup> Dec 2020 and 4<sup>th</sup> Jan 2021 with the workmen unions and officers association respectively. Since then, only one meeting was held on the first anniversary of MoU without any positive outcome.

The matters were discussed in several meetings of UFBU and accordingly taken up with IBA. An appointment was sought from the newly elected Chairman of IBA which also did not materialise. In the prevailing circumstances, the UFBU decided to launch agitation programme demanding issuance of clarifications on several matters pertaining to 11<sup>th</sup> BPS, guidelines on fitment formulae of promotion in all cadres, discussion on 5-day week, pension updation, improvement in pension related issues etc. The detail of agitation programme is given below:

**03-3-2022 : Demonstration before all Branches during lunch time/after office hours.**

**10-3-2022: Demonstration before all Branches during lunch time/after office hours.**

**15-3-2022: Centralised demonstrations in all towns and cities.**

We call upon our Units and Affiliates to participate in all programme by mobilizing members in large numbers.
