Full Text of Circular No.26/2024 of BEFI dt. 06.08.2024

We are coming across several posts/messages in the social media, since last few days, centering around 23rd Biennial Conference of Bank of India Staff Union, Kerala (affiliated to AIBEA) held at Alappuzha, Kerala on 27 July 2024.

The posts/messages have been circulated from some interested corners with ulterior motive of creating narratives that the Leftist Trade Unions are anti-national having no love to our beloved country.

These very elements, to substantiate their falsehood, have taken the anti-union, anti-bank propaganda to the common people including customers of the bank, through social media, ultimately antagonizing a section of the masses against a public sector bank and its employees.

The General Secretary of AIBEA sent a Circular (No. 29/115/2024/57 dated 31.07.2024 of AIBEA) to the undersigned from where we came to know that immediately after the aforesaid Conference, the management of Bank of India served charge-sheet on all the 13 Office Bearers of Bank of India Employees Union, Kerala.

We consider the whole exercise as extended effort of making banking industry free from trade unions. Moreover, the false propaganda is demeaning the heroic role played by the bank employees through several decades, for the nation, even sacrificing their lives during difficult times; like demonetisation, covid pandemic to name a few.

We are informed that AIBEA along with Federation of Bank of India Staff Unions have given a call to observe All India Bank Strike on 28 August 2024 in all the Banks.

In the prevailing circumstances, BEFI extends fraternal support to the strike call of AIBEA. We call upon our Units and Affiliates to rise to the occasion against the move for terrorizing the bank employees with motive of deunionisation.
